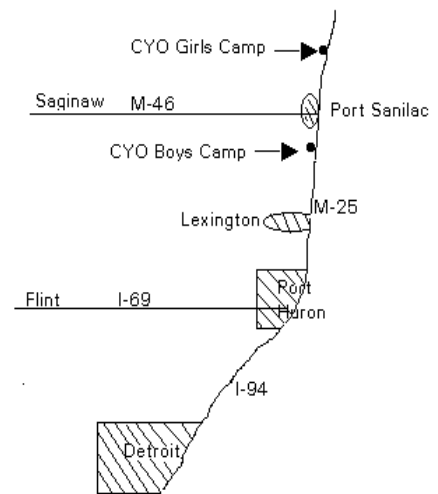

### Directions:

From the Detroit Area:

Take I-94 East to Port Huron.

Follow I-94 to end of freeway, turn left onto M-25 North (by the Citgo Gas Station). Stay on M-25 past Lexington to Port Sanilac. The CYO Boys' Camp is 2.5 miles South of Port Sanilac; the CYO Girls' Camp is 3 miles North of Port Sanilac, two guard rails past the golf course on your right.
